## Hutton Hill Rifle & Revolver Club, Inc. Safety Policy

## SAFETY IN GENERAL

- 1. Any Range Officer / Board Member has the authority to enforce all range rules on any range.
- 2. It is the duty of any member to call to the attention of the Range Officer, or Board Member any noncompliance of a range rule or unsafe condition.
- 3. No shooter shall load, commence firing, or leave the firing line without orders from the range officer
- 4. In the absence of an assigned range officer, or Board Member, a member of the group on the range must assume the responsibilities of the range officer.
- 5. No handling of firearms with anyone down range.
- 6. No shots shall be fired in any direction except towards the backstops.
- 7. Actions shall be kept open at any time a firearm is uncased, except when actually at the firing line and the range is hot.
- 8. The muzzle of all firearms shall be pointed toward the targets while at the firing line.
- 9. Center-fire rifles that have not been "sighted in" shall be "sighted in" at the 50 yd. target frame located on the left high-power range, prior to being used on any target distant further than 50 yards.
- 10. No one shall go forward of the "Firing Line" when the range is hot.
- 11. The use of any range is prohibited while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- 12. Eye and ear protection must be worn by shooters and spectators at all times.
- 13. Shotgun range-no shot larger than #6 is to be used.
- 14. Shotgun shooting guns are to be unloaded and open unless you are in the firing station.

- 15. Safety signs (red and green) shall be used at all times on all ranges.
- 17. The last member to leave the range shall see that all equipment is put in place and that the range buildings and the Bairdmore entrance is closed and locked.
- Never use damaged or unsafe equipment, report the problem to the Range Officer or a Board Member
- 19. No hand guns that are being used on the firing line are to be holstered loaded while members are down range changing targets.
- 20. Any commercial action targets must be placed following all the manufacture's recommendations. Homemade steel targets, while permitted to be used, should follow manufacture's recommendations for similar commercial targets.
- 21. Only lead, lead tipped or frangible bullets may be used on steel targets.
- 22. Only targets as outlined in the Club's target policy may be used.
- 23. If there is no one available to stay with firearm/firearms while checking on targets, members may carry their firearm/firearms with them as long as they are unloaded with the actions open.

## 25/50 YARD PISTOL RANGE

This range is for handguns, .17 and .22 rim-fire or air rifles.

- 1. Red/Green Sign system must be used at all times.
- 2. No one is allowed forward of the firing line when the range is hot..
- 3. When the Green Sign is on, all shooting must cease. Shooters must place their firearms on the bench, or in the rack, unloaded, with the actions open, slides back and cylinders out.
- 4. Magnum Pistols, rim-fire rifles and air rifles are permitted in the orange area only.
- 5. Handguns that shoot center-fire rifle ammo must shoot at the rifle range.
