Acceptable Targets

The following types of targets are acceptable for use at Hutton Hill:

- Paper targets
- Commercially manufactured targets used in accordance with the manufactures specifications, at the recommended distances, on the appropriate range, using the manufactures recommended caliber ammunition.
- Bowling Pins using center fire handgun ammunition only.
- Balls hung on string.
- Balloons secured or tethered. <u>Do not tether to target frames in a manner that will result in damage to the frame.</u>
- Aluminum cans.
- Plastic bottles.

<u>Unacceptable Targets</u>

The following types of targets are not permitted:

- Glass targets or glass bottles of any kind.
- Incendiary Targets of any kind.
- Disintegrating targets of any type, such as masonry block or concrete.

ABSOLUTELY NO CROSS FIRE PERMITTED

You must remove targets and clean up after use.

You must use the range in a safe and responsible manner. You are also responsible for your guests! Any member that violates the Club's policies will be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including revoking your membership!
